MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION Membership to 31st December 2026(*)

The Pygmy Goat Club is the official pygmy goat breed society of Great Britain. It was formed in 1982 to protect the interests and improve the status of pygmy goats in Great Britain.

Membership offers the opportunity to:

- Obtain and exchange information via the quarterly magazine "Pygmy Goat Notes", the Pygmy Goat Club website and social media forums.
- Register a herd name, enter qualifying goats into the Herd Book and non-qualifying goats into the Pet Record and to Transfer Ownership of registered goats.
- Have a voice in the affairs of the PGC and take an active part in protecting and promoting pygmy goats by participating at Pygmy Goat Club meetings and exhibiting at shows.

Members have access to the Herd Book to research breeding and ownership. They can register or transfer stock, apply for inclusion in the Breeders List, enter pygmy goat classes at agricultural shows and attend Pygmy Goat Club events such as Workshops and Webinars. Membership provides access to Pygmy Goat Club Regional Advisors, who are enthusiastic, knowledgeable and experienced pygmy goat keepers and provide advice and support. Members receive quarterly copies of 'Pygmy Goat Notes' and can read back copies and other valuable information through the Member Login area on the Pygmy Goat Club website.

SUMMARY OF RULES RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP, REGISTRATION & TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

- A breeder **MUST** be a **CURRENT MEMBER** in order to request a Herd Name and to Register qualifying goats in the Pygmy Goat Club Herd Book and non-qualifying goats into the Pet Record.
- **ALL Goats MUST be Registered by the time they are ONE YEAR OLD**
- A seller **MUST** be a **CURRENT MEMBER** in order to Transfer Ownership of goats registered to them as Owner in the Pygmy Goat Club Herd Book or Pet Record.
- **ALL Transfers of Ownership MUST be completed in ONE MONTH**

Members agree to be bound by the Club Code of Conduct.

THE CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the Pygmy Goat Club, I agree to

- abide by the rules of the club
- always behave ethically and present a positive image of the club
- consider the welfare of my goats and the best interest of the breed above any personal gain or profit
- be honest in advertising and record keeping / registration of stock
- familiarise myself with the Pygmy Goat Breed Standard and use it as a guide in breeding and evaluating pygmy goats.
