**** MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL REMINDER ****

I am writing to remind you that your membership fees are due on 1st January 2025, unless I have written to you confirming otherwise. If you are in any doubt, please contact me. Please return a renewal form so that your details can be kept up to date and matched with your payment. A renewal form is printed overleaf or you can download it from the Pygmy Goat Club's website. You can complete and scan the form (or take a photograph) or update it, and then return it by email or send it by post. You can make your payment by cheque, bank transfer or Standing Order using the information and instructions on the form.

Members have access to the Herd Book to research breeding and ownership. Membership is necessary if you intend to register or transfer stock, if you wish to apply for inclusion in the Breeders List or if you wish to enter pygmy goat classes at agricultural shows. Membership also provides access to advice and support from enthusiastic, knowledgeable and experienced pygmy goat keepers through Pygmy Goat Club's Regional Advisors. In addition, members receive copies of 'Pygmy Goat Notes', have access to the Member Login area on the Pygmy Goat Club Website and can attend Pygmy Goat Club events. We appreciate your involvement in the Pygmy Goat Club and we are very keen to hear your ideas for the future. You can include your ideas with the Membership Renewal form or send them to me or another committee member at a later date.
