## **Schedule of Classes**

## **Pet Classes**

Class 1	Kid Pet	Open to females not eligible for entry to the PGC Herd Book, and wethers, aged from 8 weeks up to 12 months on day of show.
Class 2	Adult Pet	Open to females not eligible for entry to the PGC Herd Book, and wethers, aged 12 months and over on the day of show.
Classes 3 & 4	Young Handler Classes	Entries on the day of show please to Ring Steward. Handlers must be between the ages of 5 and 16.

### **Breed Classes**

Class 5	Female kid	From 8 weeks up to 12 months on day of show. If over 6 months of age, must be registered.
Class 6	Goatling	From 1-2 years of age, not to have borne a kid.
Class 7	Adult Female	From 2, up to 7 years of age.
Class 8	Veteran Female	Aged 7 years and over.
Class 9	Male Kid	From 8 weeks up to 12 months on day of show.
Class 10	Buckling	From 1 – 2 years of age.
Class 11	Adult Male	Aged 2 years and over.
Class 12	Veteran Male	Aged 7 years and over.
Class 13	Sire & Progeny	Both sire and progeny must have been entered into their respective breed classes, to be at least two progeny present. Enter details of sire only.
Class 14	Dam & Progeny	Both dam and progeny must have been entered into their respective breed classes, to be at least one progeny present. Enter details of dam only.

#### **Rules of Entry**

- 1. The show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Pygmy Goat Club.
- 2. All exhibits must be registered in the Herd Book of the Pygmy Goat Club with the exception of female kids under 6 months of age, male kids, pet females and wethers. Registration details must be included on the entry form.
- 3. Ages to be calculated from the date of the show.
- 4. Only those goats entered, the details of which will be printed in the official catalogue, will be eligible to be shown. No substitutions will be allowed.
- 5. Pregnant goats must not be brought to the showground.
- 6. The society reserves the right, at its discretion, to amalgamate classes which have less than three entries.
- 7. Classes with only one entry will be cancelled.
